<p>6.2.</p>	<p><u>Provision of Service vehicles for identified roles</u></p> <p>MR :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Number of roles in organisation, that expectation staff will use own vehicles and in some cases, more cost effective for Service to provide the vehicle.• Also bigger picture, when looking at replacement of vehicles, we now have significant 4 wheel drive provision across the County and will probably be replacing the Hyluxes (x 5).• Look at a graph of miles per cost of different arrangements, when get to 8,500 miles, provision of vehicle becomes just as effective to supply a car.• Have 4 posts we have identified.• Fleet Manager post use to have car attached to it, and when restructure took palce this was removed to create saving. Mileage is high and if we provided we could save money and provide a further 4 x 4 vehicle in the fleet.• Then 3 x AC equivalents. We provide for uniformed staff but not for non-uniformed. Cost of extending this to ACs would be around £5200 for all 3 x posts, based on number of miles etc.• Also based on providing the Freelandrover that Officers have. ACs we given higher spec, landrover and this would be an additional £3,200 for 3 x posts, so £8K in total really.• Cars can be used but if exceptionally busy period, then we can call the cars back to use in times with extreme activity – “exceptional” operational circumstances.• If car fitted with blue lights, then do you get tax benefits? Is that fair.• RL’s view is that perhaps do the 2 x vehicles as you have a business case for this i.e. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].
