Subject of decision	Award the supply and delivery of eight (8) Super Fire Appliances to Angloco Ltd. The contract was awarded as a Further Competition under DS339-20 Emergency Response Vehicles from the Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Authority framework, Lot 3-Over 16 tonnes. The Call-Off Contract is anticipated to commence on 2nd March 2026. The initial period of the Call-Off Contract shall be 15 years, unless otherwise terminated in accordance with the Order Form and Call-Off Contract Terms and Conditions.

Reasons for the decision	HWFRS Fleet Plan 2021-25 identifies the replacement dates of vehicles this links to the Asset Management Strategy "procure, maintain and replace fleet, equipment and supply items in order to meet current and future operational needs".
Details of decision	The tender was advertised on In-Tend on the 27th November 2025 with a closing Date of 7th January 2026, this was extended until 22nd January 2026 following a clarification requested. Following a further competition Angloco Ltd have been awarded the competition due to being the Most Advantageous Tender (MAT). The Authority require eight (8) over 16 tonne Appliances. • 4x (Four) 'Super' appliances with a flat roof design to allow for RTC platforms, with two having a front mounted winch capability. • 4x (Four) 'Super' appliances with a traditional sloping roof design to allow for the stowage of 13.5m ladders. To be purchased in financial year 2025/26

	The total contract value £2,763,902 and will be paid in four stage payments. The tenders were evaluated based on Price (30%) Quality; Technical Merit (40%) Non-Technical (30%) Three tenders were received 1. Emergency One UK LTd 2. Angloco Ltd 3. WH Bence Coachworks Ltd
Details of alternative options considered and rejected (if any)	As part of this tender process HWF require alternatives chassis providers and therefore requested suppliers offer 2 vehicles that would best meet our requirements. Suppliers submitted Volvo chassis as an alternative but were unsuccessful predominantly due to the cost of change not being viable.
