Reasons for the decision	The Service is required to procure a new Occupational Health (OH) contract before the expiry of the current agreement on 31 August 2026, ensuring continued compliance with statutory duties under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and the Equality Act 2010. The existing contract currently delivers essential services including medical assessments, health surveillance, management referrals, and support for ill-health retirement decisions. Continuation of these services is vital to maintaining employee wellbeing, operational readiness, and a safe working environment
Details of decision	The tender was advertised on In-Tend on the 24th March 2026 with a closing Date of 27th April 2026. Following a CFP Heales Health Services Ltd have been awarded the competition due to being the Most Advantageous Tender (MAT). The total contract value £762,488.35 fixed for 5 years. £152,497.67 per annum. • The tenders were evaluated based on Price 40% • Resourcing, Geographical Coverage and Quality of Premises and Implementation 10% • Value Added Services 10% • Contingency Arrangements 5% • Contract Management and Reporting 5% • Data Protection Adherence and Confidentiality 5% • Case Management 5%
