Subject of decision	Award the contract to Motorola Solutions UK Ltd for Lots 1-3 for Command and Control and Communications System Lot 1- Hereford and Worcester Fire Authority and Shropshire Fire Authority Lot 2- Cleveland Fire Authority Lot 3- County Durham and Darlington Fire Authority The Authorities propose to enter into individual Contracts for each lot for a period of seven (7) years with the Contractor and continue on automatically for successive periods of twelve (12) months on each anniversary date of this Contract unless terminated by either party upon twelve (12) months prior written notice to the other party. The contract is anticipated to commence in November 2024.

Reasons for the decision	Hereford and Worcester Fire Authority was the lead in this open tender in collaboration with Shropshire and Wrekin Fire and Rescue; County Durham and Darlington Fire and Rescue and Cleveland Fire Authority. The Authorities require slight varying specifications so have been split into 3 lots for ease of response and analysis. The purpose of the procurement is to ensure resilience across the Fire Services by allowing full functionality to manage calls, radio traffic and incidents as and when required.
Details of decision	Following an open tender process Motorola have been awarded the contract due to being the Most Advantageous Tender (MAT). The opportunity was published via the Bluelight EU Supply e-Tendering Portal The total contract value £7,454,128.99 Year 1 £4,716,645.87 Year 2 £1,365,241.56 Year 3 £1,372,241.56 The price evaluation was conducted using the fixed 3-year costs for all 3 Lots (including the MDT software costs for Lot 1), then adding 3% each year to the annual cost quoted for year 3, to provide an estimate of the costs for years 4-7 allowing for annual increases in line with CPI.
