Reasons for the decision	'Working at Heights' covers all work activities where there is a possibility that a fall involving a distance liable to cause injury could occur, even if it is at or below ground level. this is regardless of the work equipment being used, the duration the person is working at height or the height at which the work is performed. The primary function of the work at height regulations 2005 (the regulations) is to legally require employers, including the FRS, to ensure that all work at height is risk assessed, properly planned, appropriately supervised and carried out in a manner which is, so far as is reasonably practicable, safe.
