The carbon monoxide from a badly adjusted camping light or stove can kill.

Barbecues in enclosed spaces are lethal, too.





Make sure your camping light and stove are clean and properly adjusted. Never take a portable barbecue – or lit charcoal – into an enclosed space like a tent or caravan.



Make sure exhaust from generators is properly vented away from occupied areas
